

# Five Star Swim Club Fall Harvest Mini Meet

November 17, 2002

MA Sanction # 0313M

This meet is open to all 8 and under swimmers registered with U. S. Swimming for 2002 or 2003. The 2002 United States Swimming Rules will apply. Swimmer's age as of November 17, 2002 governs the entire meet.

This Meet will be conducted using the No Recall false start rule. The Meet will also use the whistle command starting procedure.

**Purpose:** This meet is open to all 8 and under boys and girls. Ages 6 and under, 7 year olds, and 8 year olds will compete in their age groups. All events will be timed finals. Our goal is to conduct the meet so that it is a pleasurable event for all who attend. In keeping with this spirit, the will be conducted in a maximum time span of 4 hours in length. **Entries will be processed on a first come first served basis. Once the meet is full, late entries will be returned.**

**Site:** Lititz Community Center, 301 W. Maple St., Lititz , PA 17543; Phone (717) 626-5096; 25 yards; 8 lanes with non-turbulent lane lines and Colorado Timing System with score board. The water depth at the starting end of the pool is 12 feet.

**Awards:** Individual events 1-3 rosettes, 4-16 standard ribbons. Relay events: ribbons 1-3. Heat ribbons will be awarded. All awards must be picked up by a coach or parent representative at the conclusion of the last session or after the last event in which your team has a swimmer participating. No awards will be mailed.

**Entry Fees:** \$2.50 per individual event and \$6.00 per relay. All entry fees should be paid with one check payable to *Lititz Community Center*. **Entries must be received by 6:00 PM on Wednesday, November 6, 2002. No late or phone entries will be accepted.**

**Swimmers may compete in up to five (5) events excluding relays.**

**Officials:** Any one wishing to volunteer to officiate, please contact **Karen Shaub** at (717) 626-4159. All officials and coaches on deck must wear their official USS Membership Badge. Meet workers will be identified with a special badge. No other people will be allowed on deck.

**Safety:** Middle Atlantic Swimming Rules and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Coaches, parents, and every swimmer should become familiar with the rules and procedures. Swimmers must be under the direct supervision of a currently registered coach. All unattached swimmers must report to the safety director prior to warm-up. All swimmers must enter the water feet first from the starting end of the pool. No diving in lanes other than those designated for diving. A swimmer could be suspended from the meet for non-compliance. Safety Director for the meet is David Hagan (717) 664-2851.

**Warm-ups:** General warm-up is from 1:00 to 1:45 PM. Teams will be notified of lane assignments and warm-up schedule upon checking in at the swimming office.

**Spectators:** Admission - \$3.00 per person; Program - \$2.00. All spectators will view the meet from a two hundred and fifty (250) seat balcony. A concession stand will be available. Parking is available on the Community Center lot and on adjacent school parking lots.

**Final Results:** A copy of the results will be available to coaches who submitted entries on disk at the conclusion of the meet. Results will be posted on the Middle Atlantic website.

**Entries: Entries must be received by 6:00 PM on Wednesday, November 6, 2002.** All entries should be made on a computer 3 1/2 inch disc using the Hy-Tek Commlink Program. A hard copy must accompany disc. If using Commlink is not possible, the official entry form must be used. There is a \$2.00 surcharge per swimmer if a club does not submit entries on a disc. If entries are faxed, the original forms must be received by the November 6th deadline. **No late or phone entries will be accepted.** Swimmers with incomplete or illegible USS numbers will be rejected. All entries must be swimmers best times and are subject to Middle Atlantic penalties. Entry corrections will be accepted only from the coach or team representative listed on the entry form. Deck entries will be accepted at the meet director's discretion. The cost will be \$5.00 per entry. Deck entries will not be eligible for awards. All deck entries will be handled by the meet director prior to the start of the session.
