

Five Swim Club Winter Carnival A/BB/C Meet With Relays

January 10 & 11, 2004

This meet is open to all 9 and over swimmers registered with U.S. Swimming for 2004. The 2004 United States Swimming Rules will apply. Swimmer's ages as of January 10, 2004 governs the entire meet. This meet will be conducted using the No Recall false start rule. The Meet will also use the whistle command starting procedure.

Purpose: The purpose of the meet is for coaches to bring their entire team together to evaluate midseason times in a wide variety of events. Our goal is to conduct the meet so that it is a pleasurable event for all who attend. In keeping with this spirit, all of our sessions will be conducted in a maximum time span of 4 hours in length. **Entries will be limited or the meet format may be changed if needed to conduct the meet within the time span listed in the order of events form.**

Site: Lititz Community Center, 301 W. Maple St., Lititz, PA; 25 yards; 8 lanes with non-turbulent lane lines and Colorado Timing System with score board. The water depth at the starting end of the pool is 12 feet. **Emergency calls the day(s) of the meet may be made to (717) 626-5096.**

Awards: This is a timed finals meet. The meet will be preseeded and scored on each level (A, B, C) for each event. The top eight (8) times in each level will receive awards. A entries: medals 1st to 3rd, ribbons to 8th; B entries: large rosettes 1st to 3rd, ribbons to 8th; C entries: regular ribbons 1st to 8th. There will be no awards for the 15 and over age group. Award levels will be determined by the entry times. All awards must be picked up by a coach or parent representative at the conclusion of the last session or after the last event in which your team has a swimmer participating. No awards will be mailed.

Entry Fees: \$3.00 per individual event, \$6.00 per relay event. **Entries must be received by 6:00 PM on Tuesday, December 30, 2003. No late or phone entries will be accepted.**

Swimmers may compete in up to five (5) events per day.

Swimmers must provide their own timer and lap counter for the 1000 and the 1650 Free.

Officials: Any one wishing to volunteer or officiate, please contact **Karen Shaub** at (717) 626-4159. All officials and coaches on deck must wear their official USS Membership Badge. Meet workers will be identified with a special badge. No other people will be allowed on deck.

Safety: Middle Atlantic Swimming Rules and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Coaches, parents, and every swimmer should become familiar with the rules and procedures. Swimmers must be under the direct supervision of a currently registered coach. All unattached swimmers must report to a safety director prior to warm-up. All swimmers must enter the water feet first from the starting end of the pool. No diving in lanes other than those designated for diving. A swimmer could be suspended from the meet for non-compliance. Safety Director for the meet is David Hagan (717) 664-2851.

Warm-ups: First Session Each Day: General Warm-ups from 7:00 to 8:15. Sprint lanes will be open 7:55 to 8:10. Second Session Each Day: General Warm-ups from 11:30 to 1:00. **Should the swimmer entries for the second session exceed 220 people, the session will be split into an 11-12 session and a third session will be added for 9-10's.** This allows adequate space during warm-up and deck space during the meet. Teams will be contacted if this division of ages becomes necessary.

Spectators: Admission-\$3.00 per person/per day. Program covering all sessions-\$5.00. All spectators will view the meet from a two hundred and fifty (250) seat balcony. A concession stand will be available. Parking is available on the Community Center lot and on adjacent school parking lots.

Final Results: A copy of the results will be available to coaches who submitted entries on a disk at the conclusion of the meet. Final results will be posted on the Middle Atlantic website.

Entries: Entries must be received by 6:00 PM on Tuesday, December 30, 2003. All entries should be made on a computer 3 ½ inch disk using the Hy-Tek Commlink Program. A hard copy must accompany a disk. If using Commlink is not possible, the official entry form must be used. There is a \$2.00 surcharge per swimmer if a club does not submit entries on a disk. If entries are faxed, the original forms must be received by the December 30 deadline. **No late or phone entries will be accepted.** Swimmers with incomplete or illegible USS members will be rejected. All entries must be swimmers best times and are subject to Middle Atlantic penalties. Entry corrections will be accepted only from the coach or team representative listed on the entry form. Deck entries will be accepted at the meet director's discretion. The cost will be \$6.00 per entry. Deck entries will not be eligible for awards. All deck entries will be handled by the meet director prior to the start of the session. Any swimmer whose entries are cut due to eliminated events or heats will have their entry fee refunded.
