<b>FACILITIES</b>	The Atlantic City Sports Complex pool –is an eight-lane twenty-five meter facility with numerous amenities. A full eight-lane Colorado display board accompanies our electronic timing system. Depth of the pool at the starting end is 12 feet, four feet at the turn end. <b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	This meet is open to any registered USA Swimming member and will be conducted according to the current USA Swimming Code of Regulations. The age of the swimmer on March 6, 2004 will determine the swimmer's age group. Swimmers may participate in a maximum of five events per day.
<b>ENTRY LIMITATIONS</b>	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries, events or heats, or to modify the meet format to conform to Middle Atlantic rules. Swimmers/teams eliminated will be given a full refund.
<b>DECK ENTRIES</b>	Subject to space availability, and at the discretion of the Meet Director, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet, prior to the start of each session, at the cost of \$5 per event. Deck-entered swimmers will compete unofficially; the achieved time is official, but will not score in the meet for points or awards. To enter, please see the MD before or during warm-ups.

<b>SWIMMERS WITHOUT A COACH</b>	Swimmers unaccompanied by a credentialed coach must report to the Meet Director before the warm-up.
<b>SEEDING</b>	This meet is a pre-seeded timed-final meet.
<b>HOW TO ENTER</b>	Entry times must be submitted in the course in which they were achieved. Long course meter and short course yard times will be converted by meet management for seeding purposes and the meet will be seeded in short course meters. Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Commlink software. A hard copy printout from Team Manager and the Commlink file must accompany the diskette or e-mail. Any team with five (5) or more swimmers that does not submit their entries using Hy-Tek Commlink files will be charged \$5.00 per swimmer.

<b>ENTRY DEADLINE</b>	Entries must be received by Friday, February 27, 2004. Checks should be made payable to Atlantic City Aquatic Club.
<b>RULES</b>	This meet will be conducted according to current USA Swimming rules. Middle Atlantic Swimming rules shall also apply. USA SWIMMING / MA SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ENTIRE MEET. Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes and essential meet personnel will be permitted on deck. Penalties will be imposed upon any swimmer when any coach, parent or swimmer enters any time other than the swimmer's best time for any event. Penalties may include fines or suspension.
<b>SCORING &amp; AWARDS</b>	Awards will be provided to swimmers based on times achieved at the meet. All Senior events will offer awards for swimmers aged 14 & under and also separate awards for swimmers aged 15 & over.
<b>PROGRAMS &amp; ADMISSION</b>	\$3.00 program covers all sessions \$2.00 admission per session
