**Location:** Germantown Academy, Morris Road, Fort Washington, PA 19034--215.542.9095

**Facility:** 25 yard, 6 lane pool, entry depth 12' feet, Colorado Timing system, Anti-turbulent lane lines, balcony seating for spectators, snack bar, ample free parking at pool site, near-by lodging and restaurants.

**Entries:** Entries should be sent on a 3 1/2" floppy disk compatible with Hy-tek Meet Manager (with hard copy and meet recap). You may also email entries to Pete Crippen - [CH127533@aol.com](mailto:CH127533@aol.com). Limited to 5 individual entries/day. Swimmers must enter with their best times or be subject to penalties set by Middle Atlantic Swimming. (These penalties could include a swimmer's suspension from competition for a minimum of 3 months, but not more than one year.) If a swimmer does not have an official time, please enter NT. Meet Director reserves the right to limit the number of entries/event in order to conduct a fair meet. If this is necessary, those affected will be notified prior to the date of the meet and will be issued a refund. **ALL ENTRIES AND/OR PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED BY Noon (12PM) THURSDAY, October 28 for entries to be accepted. Fax (215) 641-2540** This meet is a pre-seeded, timed final meet. No late entries will be accepted.

**DECK ENTRIES** - \$6/entry - WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MEET DIRECTOR. Deck-entered swimmers will compete unofficially; the time achieved is official but will not be awarded. Please see the meet director before warm-ups.

**Eligibility:** The meet is open to all swimmers registered with USA Swimming for 2004/2005 and will be conducted according to current US Swimming Code of Regulations. Swimmers' age as of the first day of the meet governs the age for the entire meet. Any swimmer who is unattached or not accompanied by a coach will be assigned to a team area with a coach.

**Fees:** \$3.00/individual event. **If entries are not on a disk please add a \$5 surcharge for processing of hand entries.** Make checks payable to GAAC and mail to Richard Shoulberg, Germantown Academy, 340 Morris Road, Fort Washington, PA 19034. **Awards:** "A"--Medals 1st thru 3rd, Ribbons 4th thru 6th; "B"--Rosettes 1st thru 3rd, Ribbons 4th thru 6th; "C"--Ribbons 1st thru 6th. They will be based on the level at which the swimmer entered the meet. Awards will be available after last session.

**Awards will be mailed to the teams following the meet if an address is provided.**

**Admission:** \$3.00/session - includes heat sheet

**Meet Results:** Will be posted to the Middle Atlantic website ([www.maswim.org](http://www.maswim.org)) and transmitted by email to any club that provides a valid email address. Meet results will not be mailed to the clubs.

Only 2004/2005 USS Certified Coaches and Officials will be allowed on deck. You must wear your card at all times.

**Directions to Pool:**

Take exit 26 of PA Turnpike--Ft. Washington. Through tolls stay in left lane to end of road, then go right (Pennsylvania Avenue). Follow to dead end and turn left (Old Bethlehem Pike). Then immediately after crossing over railroad bridge - - turn right (between Rich's Deli and Marita's Cantina). Take next immediate right around Marita's Cantina onto Morris Road. First pillared driveway on the left--entrance to the Academy. Parking lot on left. Arrows posted for walk through quad and building to pool entrance. Lockerrooms on lower level.
