<b>LOCATION</b>	University of Delaware's Harry Rawstrom Natatorium Bob Carpenter Sports Building Day of Meet ONLY emergency phone #: 302-831-2644
<b>FACILITIES</b>	8-lane, 25-yard pool with 4 feet of water at the starting end. Separate 6-lane 20-yard pool will be available for continuous warm-up/warm-down. Competitor non-turbulent lane lines. Colorado System 5 timing system with separate lane readout. Hy-Tek Meet Manager software is used to manage meet entries and results. Spectator seating for 700 is available in the balcony. Refreshments: Snack bar and coach/volunteer hospitality will be provided.
<b>PARKING/ DIRECTIONS</b>	From I-95, take exit 1B Newark, Rt. 896 North. Follow Rt. 896 for approximately 3 miles. Rt. 896 will become S. College Ave. Follow until it dead ends at light at Main St. Turn left at light and make immediate right onto Old College Ave. First driveway on right goes toward the pool (for drop off only). Parking is located across the railroad tracks, opposite side of the pool. Additional parking is located in the parking garage at the end of Main Street. If using mapquest, use the address: 60 North College Avenue, Newark DE 19711. This is Unique Impressions and is located next to the pool.

<b>OFFICIALS</b>	Please contact Meet Director if you are able to officiate.
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	This meet is open to all swimmers registered with USA Swimming. Swimmers age is as of October 16, 2006. No proof of time is required, as there are no qualifying times. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events, plus relays.

<b>ENTRY LIMITATIONS</b>	The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries, events or heats, or to modify the meet format to conform to Middle Atlantic rules. Swimmers/teams eliminated from the meet due to time or space constraints will be given a full refund.
<b>ORDER OF EVENTS</b>	See attached sheet listing the order of events and event numbers.
<b>WARM-UP PROCEDURES</b>	Warm-up: NO DIVING OFF BLOCKS OR THE EDGE OF THE POOL during this time. The last 10 minutes of warm-up will be sprints, with all starts beginning at the starting block end of the pool. Swimmers must swim one length of the pool and exit the pool at the opposite end. Swimmers must be under the direct supervision of a currently registered USA Swimming coach. Lane assignments for warm-up will be posted, as needed, at the meet.
<b>START TIMES</b>	Warm-up: 11:00 am Meet Start: 12:00 pm
<b>DECK ENTRIES</b>	Subject to space availability and at the discretion of the Meet Director, deck entries will be accepted on the day of the meet, prior to the start of the session, at the cost of \$5.00 per event. Deck-entered swimmers will compete unofficially; the achieved time is official but will not score in the meet for points or awards. <b>Swimmers not already entered in the meet must present proof of current USA Swimming registration.</b> To enter, please see the Meet Director before or during warm-ups.
<b>SWIMMERS WITHOUT A COACH</b>	Swimmers unaccompanied by a USA Swimming credentialed coach should report to the Meet Director before the warm-up for the meet.
<b>FORMAT</b>	This is a pre-seeded, timed finals Mini Meet.
<b>HOW TO ENTER</b>	Entry times are to be submitted in the course in which they were achieved: LCM, SCM, or SCY. Times submitted in a course other than SCY will not be treated as non-conforming times. "NO TIMES" will be accepted.  All entries must be submitted manually on the attached TD non-computer entry form (Swimmer's USA Swimming Registration # must be clearly included) OR on a 3 ½ inch disk. If you have the Hy-Tek computer programs Team

	<p>Manager and COMMLINK, submit the following printouts along with the diskette: 1 printout from COMMLINK of entries, 1 printout from COMMLINK of swimmers, 1 printout from Team Manager of the meet entries – separate the boys and girls and sort by age.</p> <p>You must complete the <b>TD Meet Summary Form</b> and mail with the entry whether you use the disk entry, or manual entry form. A club contact person must be listed on the entry summary form, including an e-mail address. A \$5.00 surcharge per swimmer will be imposed on teams that have submitted a non-computer entry with 10 or more swimmers. This processing fee must be included with your entries.</p>

<b>ENTRIES DUE</b>	<b>October 5, 2006 by 5:00 pm.</b> No late entries accepted.
<b>RULES</b>	<p>This meet will be conducted according to current USA Swimming rules. Middle Atlantic Swimming rules shall also apply. USA SWIMMING / MA SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WARM-UP PROCEDURES WILL BE IN EFFECT FOR THE ENTIRE MEET.</p> <p>Only currently credentialed coaches, USA Swimming registered athletes, and essential meet personnel will be permitted on deck.</p> <p>This meet will be conducted using the Whistle command, supplemented with verbal commands, and No-Recall False Start procedures.</p>

	Penalties will be imposed upon any swimmer when any coach, parent, or swimmer enters a time other than the swimmer's best time for any event. Penalties may include fine or suspension.
<b>AWARDS</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> – 3 <sup>rd</sup> individual event: Large Rosette Ribbons 4 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> individual event: Standard Ribbons 1 <sup>st</sup> – 3 <sup>rd</sup> relay event: Standard Ribbons
<b>ADMISSION/ PROGRAM</b>	\$3.00
<b>VOLUNTEERS</b>	A free program and refreshments will be offered to those volunteering to assist with the operation of the meet by serving as timers, runners, or in any other function as designated by the Meet Director.
